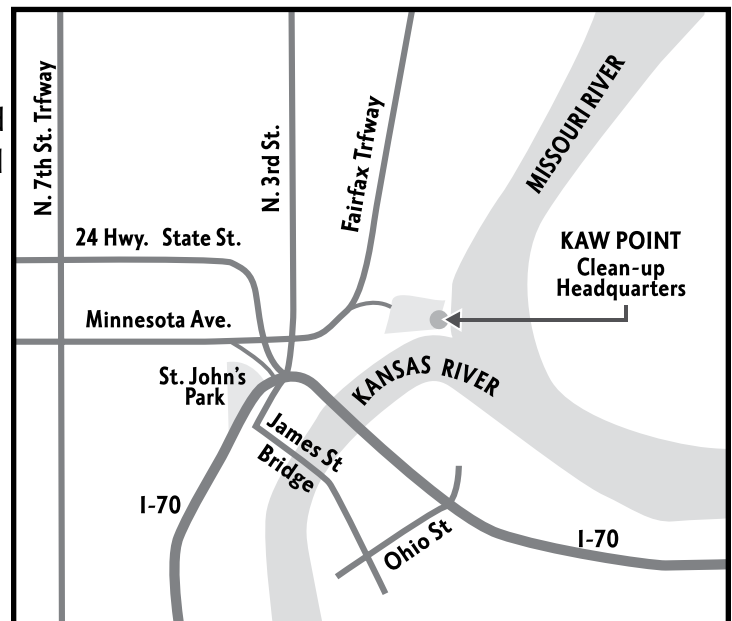
Help Clean Up the BIG MUDDY!

KAW POINT PARK - Saturday, OCTOBER 3, 2009

Kaw Point Park is at the confluence of the Missouri and Kaw Rivers in Kansas City, KS

- **Clean-up time:** 9am to 3pm , Sat., October 3, 2009
- **Volunteers should:** Wear work clothes and sturdy footwear (no sandals.) Bring sunscreen, bug spray and refillable water bottle. Come ready to get muddy and have fun on the river!!!
- **What we will provide:** Work gloves, drinking water, trash bags, tools, boat rides to clean-up sites and lunch for all volunteers.
- **Directions to Kaw Point Park:**
FROM THE WEST (from Kansas): I-70 East & North along the Kaw River Strawberry Hill area to James Street Exit #423. Take James Street through 1st stop sign and follow signs to Fairfax Blvd. The bottom of the ramp is #1 Fairfax Blvd. Look for the KAW POINT sign to your right. Turn right after the sign into the parking lot and follow signs to the park.

FROM THE EAST (from Missouri West on Lewis and Clark Bridge I-70 from KC Mo): Take the Fairfax exit # 423 on the right then down the ramp to the park.
